The Basics of Photoshop

The application is available for Windows, Mac OS X, and mobile device (iOS and Android). The software is capable of creating layers and enables raster based editing. Creating Layers

Each layer, which is an object similar to a sheet of cutout cardboard, is made out of a predefined background image. The

layers display as squares called "boxes" in the canvas where the user can add artwork and other types of images. Layers are created by placing the desired artwork over the blank canvas using the Layer button. Zoom and Pan Zooming out beyond the canvas makes it easy to see the completed version of an image that is composed of several layers of different images.

Zooming in makes it easier to view smaller details in an image. The Zoom tool is available in the toolbar. The user can also pan to an area using the mouse. A pan box indicates where the cursor has been placed. Frequently used Layers may be placed on top of other layers, creating a new layer to work in. This is necessary when the user wants to work on several images at

once. The Layer panel contains several buttons that enable you to add, combine, and remove images as you work. The Move tool is used for moving layers around and for aligning layers to other layers. Deleting an image layer will delete it from the canvas, allowing you to start over. Getting Introduced to Photoshop Getting started with Photoshop can be a bit

difficult for those new to the application, but with a bit of patience and practice, it'll be very rewarding. Begin by choosing an image to manipulate. Double-click on the image, and a blank canvas will appear on the screen. On a Mac, the user will only see the backdrop. The user must use the Layer tools to create a blank canvas for each new layer. Using the Layer

Tools The user must use the Layer tools to add new objects to the canvas. In order to do so, place them on the canvas. Each image is assigned a Layer in the Layers panel. There are several default layer names, including Background, Layer 0, Layer 1, Layer 2, and Layer 3. A layer is transparent unless specified otherwise.
